DECEMBER 7th . . . 84 YEARS AGO

CORPUS CHRISTI - The USS Lexington Museum will hold a Remembrance Ceremony on Sunday, December 7th, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. to commemorate the 84th anniversary of the 1941 surprise attack on Pearl Harbor. The ceremony, which will honor those who died in the attack, will feature the Corpus Christi Veterans Band and the Corpus Christi Pipes & Drums. The invocation will be given by Pastor Doug Wasinger, who is a USS Lexington Museum Volunteer. The National Anthem will be sung by Mick Boudreau. In Navy tradition, a wreath will be laid in the water followed by Taps.
